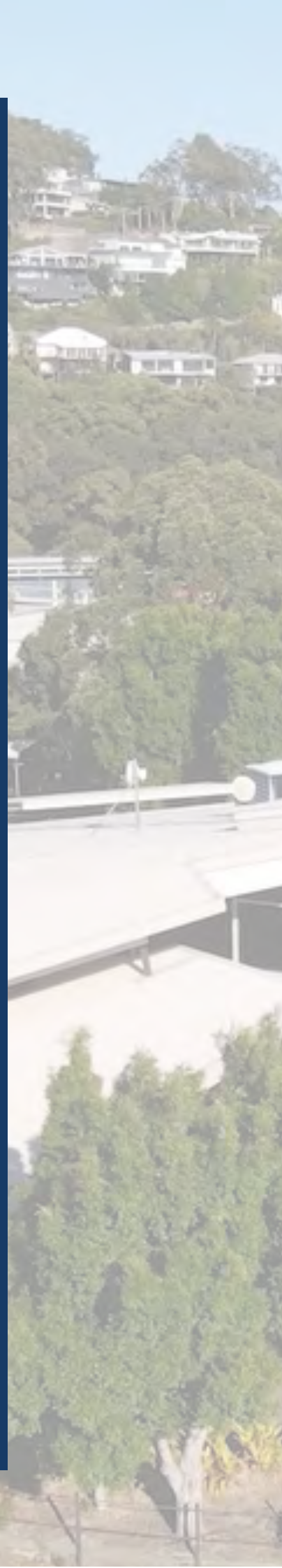

What is Immanuel Church?

The church is not the building (we call our building the "Worship Centre"). The church is not even an organisation. The church is the people — you!

It's a real, genuine, messy, talented, growing people — in community together. A church our size means we find community in smaller groups (we call these "Life Groups").

Immanuel Lutheran Church, originally based in Maroochydore, formed as a congregation in 1960. We moved to our present location in Buderim (co-located with Immanuel College) in 1999. We've been active on the Sunshine Coast for 60+ yrs.





Our values

Jesus is the Way. The path, road, journey and destination is Jesus — the Way. He is our goal and our future. The only reason that such a diverse bunch of people called "Immanuel Church" can work so well together is because we are unified by Jesus Christ. Jesus brings us together as a family and he gives us a reason to work for something greater. (*John 14:16*)

Everything starts with prayer. Prayer is resting in the presence of God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Every ministry, worship time, meeting and act of service comes from a place of prayer. (*1 Thessalonians 5:16-18*)

Grace changes people. People don't change by being told, commanded, manipulated, forced or made to change. They change through the unconditional gift of God's love. We do not believe that the 'Law' changes people — it points out our failing and need. Real change comes from the Spirit. (*Romans 8:3*)

Compassion calls us beyond ourselves. Our church does not exist for itself or for its members. We are here for the wider world. God's compassion calls us outside our comfort zones and our homes — to serve and give of ourselves. Going beyond ourselves is the way of Jesus! (*John 3:16*)

Generations grow deeper together. To grow into mature disciples (learners and apprentices) of Jesus it takes all ages. Young people grow deeper when they learn from the faith of older ones. Older people grow and get encouragement from exploring the faith of younger generations. (*Hebrews 13:7*)

Added to the above, we are a *Lutheran* church, so our beliefs are summarised in the Lutheran Confessions, including the Augsburg Confession.

Worship

Here at Immanuel Church, we balance deep and ancient traditions with language and customs that speak to us today. Our worship is faithful to God's word in Scripture, vibrant, and involves all generations.

God is active during our worship times:

- * God gathers us, we come;
- * God speaks, we listen;
- * God forgives our sin, we confess our sin;
- * God offers himself in the person of Jesus Christ, we respond by offering ourselves, our gifts, our talents.
